## Enterprise Bargaining Update

Dear Team,

Today we met with your union representatives and delegates to commence negotiations for our next Rolling Stock Enterprise Agreement.

The bargaining team for Rolling Stock included **Danny Walsh**, Business Strategy Manager, **Cameron Murray**, Depot Manager and **Mark Stefani**, Fleet Manager X'Trapolis.

### What was discussed today?

We exchanged our log of claims relating to employment terms and conditions outlined in the Agreement. We spent time understanding each other's claims and seeking clarity on what is important to you and for our business.

Metro spoke about the need for a modern, progressive Agreement with clauses that are easier for everyone to understand, including Metro, our people and the unions. We also spoke about the needs of the future network and fleet cascade and what that means for people in Rolling Stock.

Roster changes that we see as important within Rolling Stock were also discussed. Your union representatives provided some strong feedback on the current roster change activities that we have been communicating across the depots. Metro will take this feedback on board as we progress in accordance with the roster arrangement process.

### What will happen next?

Our next bargaining meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 3 April**, and we will send you another update after this meeting.
