AUDIENCE

This course must be undertaken by any individual required to operate a road/rail vehicle within a “restricted” environment, i.e. within a worksite protected by a method of safeworking.

PREREQUISITES

Prior completion of:

- TLIF2080 Safely access the Rail Corridor* (TTSA).

*Units of competency considered equivalent on www.training.gov.au are also accepted.

Other Requirements:

- Category 1 Rail Safety Health Assessment
- Current drivers licence.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) REQUIREMENTS

Participants must bring the following items on the day of training:

- Steel capped, lace up boots with ankle support
- Long sleeve shirt
- Full length trousers
- Rail approved high visibility vest/shirt
- Hard hat
- Eye protection.
