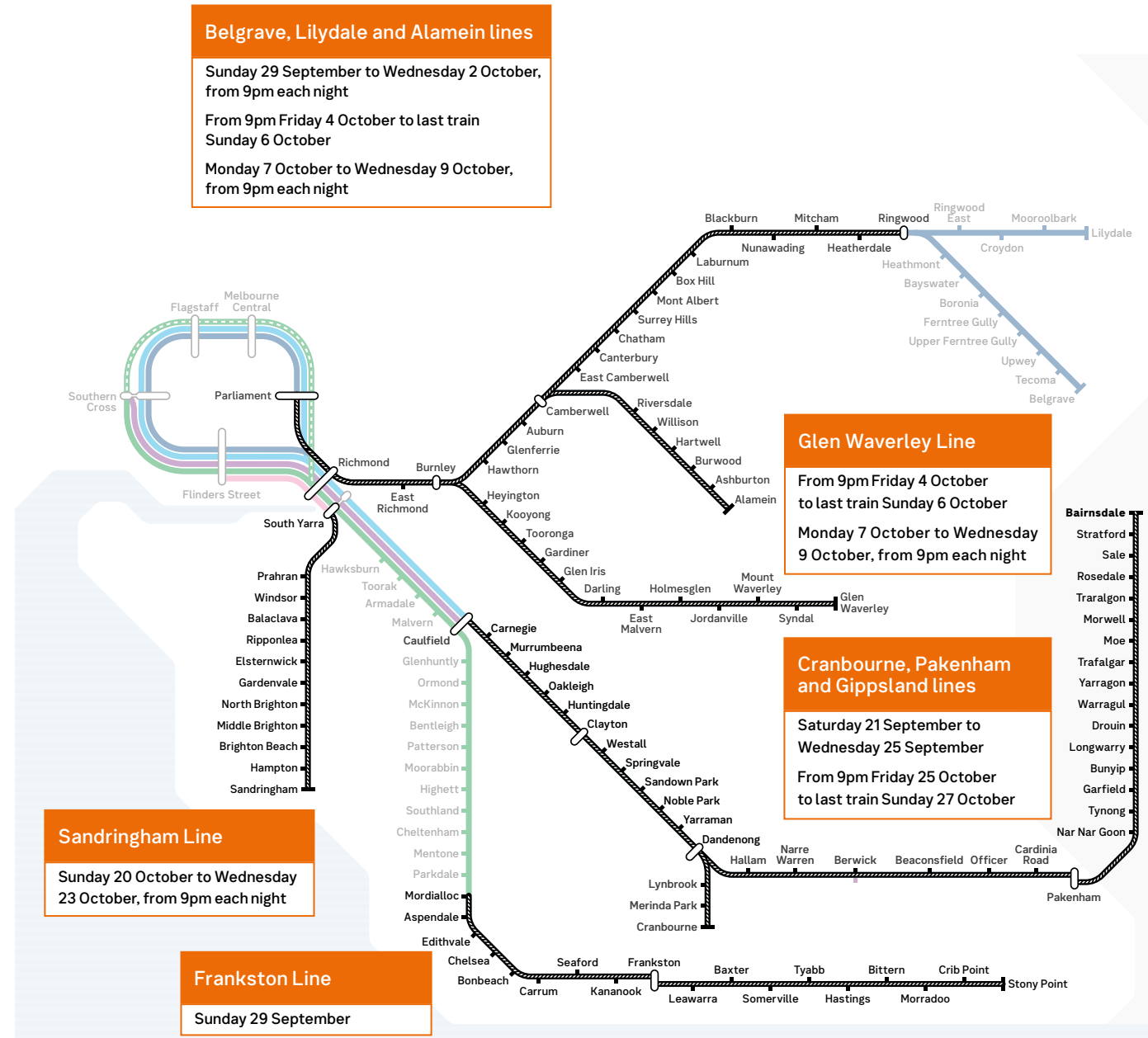

Delivering the Metro Tunnel

Thanks for your patience as we deliver major works on our roads and rail lines across Melbourne to prepare the network for the Metro Tunnel.

The Metro Tunnel will provide space on the rail network for over half a million extra trips to and from the suburbs during peak periods each week and reduce travel times by up to 50 minutes a day. It will also help take cars off our busy roads.

Plan ahead to avoid long delays

From Saturday 21 September to last train Wednesday 25 September, buses will replace trains on sections of the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines.

Coaches will also replace V/Line services on the Gippsland Line.

We estimate an additional 45 minutes will be added to most people's journey.

Please be aware that from Saturday 21 September to Sunday 27 October, buses will also replace trains at various times across the network.

To help you plan ahead, here are some tips:

- If you can, avoid peak times and travel before 7am or after 9am.
- Remember the Early Bird fare. Touch on and off a metropolitan train before 7.15am weekdays and that part of your journey is free.
- Footy fans should allow extra time to get to the game.

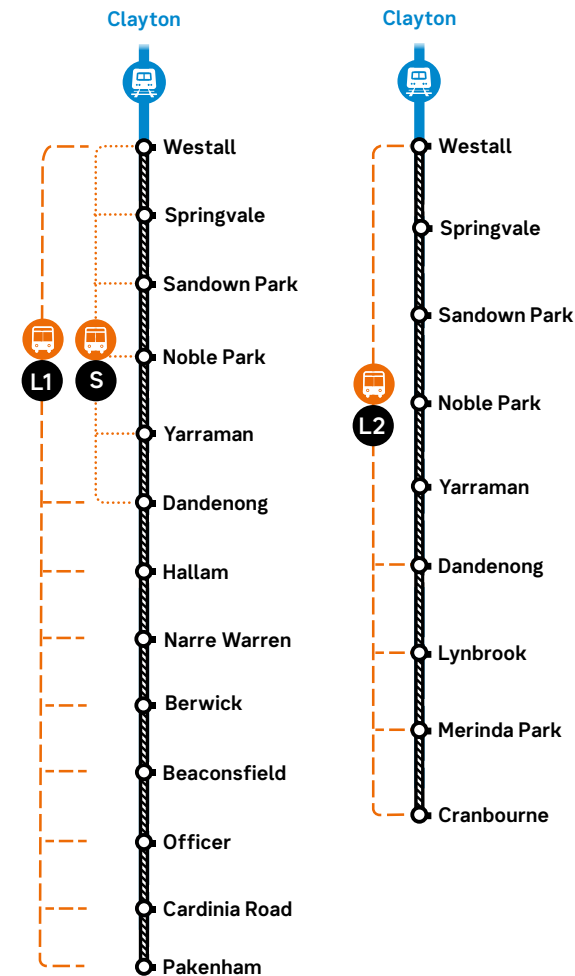

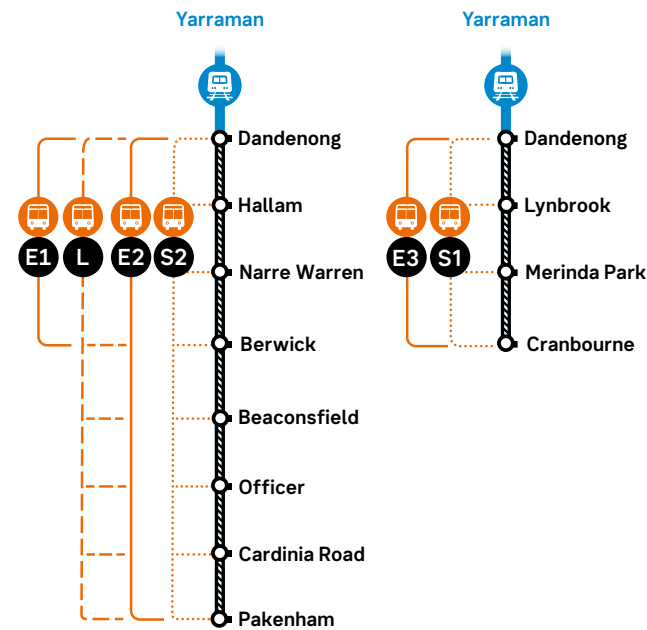
