Yesterday (13 August 2019) and today (14 August 2019), we met with both the Rail and Locomotive Divisions of the RTBU to continue negotiations for our next Rail Operations Enterprise Agreement.

We spent some time yesterday identifying the high-priority claims from both parties, as a means of increasing the pace and intensity of negotiations.

We've made progress and agreed on some clauses, and had positive discussion on others.

What will happen next?

We are scheduled to meet with both the Rail and Locomotive Divisions on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday next week (19, 21 and 22 August 2019). We will continue to update you on how negotiations progress in these meetings.

Metro remains committed to reaching an agreement as quickly as possible, and will continue to negotiate and work with your representatives to finalise your new Agreement.
