What's happening

Works are continuing on the revitalisation of Carrum's four new community spaces, with a town square, a station garden and the new village green opening by late July 2020.

A new shared use path along Station Street and the new walking and cycling underpass at Eel Race Road will also be complete.

There's still more to come, with the McLeod Road extension to the beach and foreshore park expected to be complete and open by late 2020.
