Last Thursday and Friday we returned to the Fair Work Commission (FWC) with the Locomotive Division of the RTBU to continue negotiations for our next Rail Operations Enterprise Agreement (EA).

What was discussed?

A number of claims for both Metro and the RTBU were discussed at length over the course of the two days of bargaining. These include:

- Depots
- Master roster change
- Train Movements and Supplementary Labour
- Decentralisation
- Part-time shift drivers
- 'Commitment by the Parties' clause
- Discretionary Day Off (DDOs)
- Operating groups

What's next?

This Thursday 31st October there will be a meeting of senior representatives from both Metro and the RBTU at the Fair Work Commission to discuss the progress of negotiations and our intent to get this deal done as soon as possible. Further meetings will continue in following weeks. Metro is keen to negotiate a new Enterprise Agreement as soon as possible.
