Bikes and pets   

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

Cheltenham and Mentone station closures

Cheltenham and Mentone stations will close on **Friday 20 March** to allow for works to continue as we remove three level crossings at Balcombe, Charman and Park roads, and rebuild Cheltenham and Mentone stations.

There will be no trains stopping at Cheltenham and Mentone during this period.

A shuttle bus service will operate between Southland and Parkdale stations to connect passengers to train services.

The new Cheltenham Station will open in **August 2020**.

The new Mentone Station will open in **mid July 2020**.

Road disruptions

To enable extensive level crossing works to take place there will be the following temporary road closures in Cheltenham during late March and April.

- Park Road will be closed between Hall Street and the Cheltenham Park gate between **Friday 20 March and Friday 24 April**.
- Charman Road will be closed between Station Road and Blagdon Street on **Saturday 21 March and Sunday 22 March**.

Local bus route changes

Several local bus services will be affected by these works. Diversions and affected bus stops can be found at ptv.vic.gov.au or by calling **1800 800 007**.

Plan ahead to avoid long delays

During this major disruption, we're giving buses the green light. This means replacement buses will have a smoother journey along key routes, helping traffic flow and getting you where you need to be via the quickest route possible.

To help during this time, here are some tips:

- Plan ahead and allow more time for your journey.
- If you can, avoid the peak and consider alternatives where possible.
- Please be aware of more people using alternative roads, train lines or routes, if their usual journey is disrupted.
- Touch on and off on the metropolitan train network before 7.15am to get free travel.

April disruptions

Buses will replace trains between Moorabbin and Mordialloc from **7.45pm each night between Monday 6 April and Thursday 9 April**.

Works may also be carried out on the Frankston line as part of regular maintenance and renewal programs which may impact train services.

May disruptions

Buses will replace trains between Moorabbin and Mordialloc from **Saturday 23 May to mid July**.

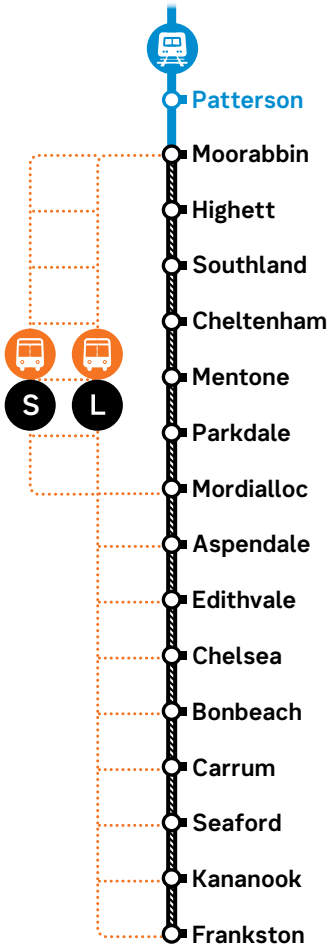

Evenings only from 7.45pm each night between Monday 23 March and Wednesday 25 March

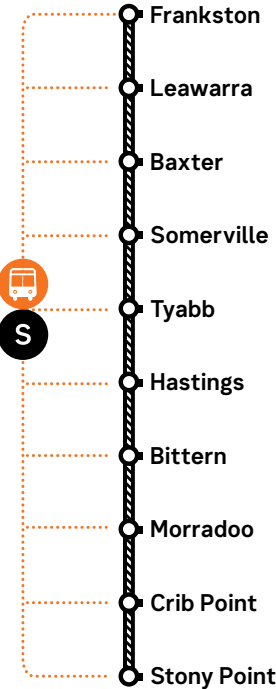
