**Bikes and pets**   

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

### Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

## Road and bus disruptions

To enable extensive level crossing removal works to take place there will be the following temporary road and pedestrian closures in Cheltenham and Mentone.

- Park Road will be closed between Hall Street and the Cheltenham Park gate from **Saturday 23 May to Monday 8 June.**
- Charman Road will be closed between Station Road and Blagdon Street from **Saturday 23 May to Thursday 11 June.**
- Balcombe Road will be closed between Como Parade West and Swanston Street from **Thursday 14 May to Monday 22 June.**

## Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers and the community is our key priority as we continue to remove level crossings along the Frankston Line, as is supporting physical distancing measures in line with current health advice.

There is increased cleaning across the public transport network to slow the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19), including rail replacement buses.

This includes nightly sanitation of all trains, trams, and buses, including wiping down all touch surfaces and entirely spraying with disinfectant. There will also be enhanced cleaning during bus layovers at major interchanges.

# We're busy removing level crossings

As part of Victoria's Big Build, we're removing 75 dangerous and congested level crossings with 35 already gone. On the Frankston Line, we're removing 18 crossings and building 12 new stations.

While you're on the bus, we will dig out the rail trenches, get rid of the boom gates at Park and Charman roads in Cheltenham and Balcombe Road in Mentone.

Once the line reopens on **Monday 27 July**, a shuttle bus service will operate between Southland and Parkdale stations from **Monday 27 July to Sunday 2 August** and between Southland and Mentone stations until **Sunday 16 August** to connect passengers to train services.

The new Mentone Station will open on **Monday 3 August** and the new Cheltenham Station will open on **Monday 17 August**.

From **1am Saturday 20 June to Sunday 21 June** Metro Tunnel will also be undertaking works between Caulfield and Moorabbin. For more information about Metro Tunnel and other projects visit [bigbuild.vic.gov.au](http://bigbuild.vic.gov.au)

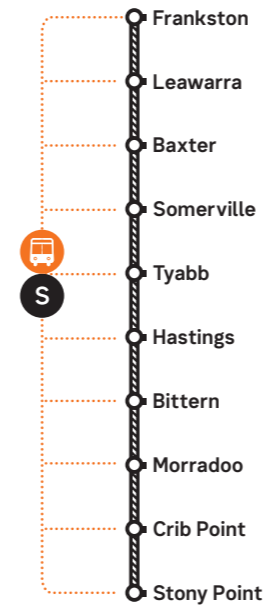

From **8pm to last service on Sunday 24 May**, buses replace trains between Parliament and Mordialloc. Buses also replace trains on the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines between Parliament and Caulfield and on the Sandringham Line between Parliament and Elsternwick during this time.
