

Safely Work in the Rail Corridor (SWIRC) Information

AUDIENCE

This course is designed to provide new entrants to the rail industry the necessary safety skills and knowledge required to undertake their role. This course will take place within a simulated rail environment (Newport) to provide participants with a real experience of 'a day in the life of the rail network'.

Mandatory compliance

An employer must not knowingly allow a new entrant to undertake any construction work on MTM Project Sites unless the person holds a current RIW card with the MTM Operator Role, including SWIRC from 01/02/2020.

1 day (7:45am to 16:00)

PREREQUISITES

TLIF2080 Safely Access the Rail Corridor (Metro approved)

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Current Rail Industry Worker (RIW) card holders must have current employment with an organisation that is authorised to interface with the Metro Trains Melbourne rail network.

PRIOR TO ATTENDING

Videos and feedback forms are available via QR codes. Participants requested to download the

free 'QINCODESAFE' app and complete the SWIRC pre-training knowledge survey prior to attending.



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Participants must bring the following items on the day of training:

- Hard hat
- Eye protection
- Long sleeve shirt and trousers
- Gloves
- Rail approved orange high visibility vest/ shirt
- Steel cap, lace up boots with ankle support

Note: Participants who fail to bring the required work on project sites, on MTM Network, unless PPE will NOT be able to participate.

DELIVERY MODE

Face-to-face delivery including participation in outdoor activities on track

Activities include:

- Virtual Reality
- Working at Heights
- Working around mobile plant
- Setting up light towers

Students are expected to participate in all activities (fit for work). A theory assessment will be undertaken by all participants.
