

## Health and safety

Maintenance and renewal works have been deemed critical under current restrictions and works will continue with strict health and safety protocols in place.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority. Workers on these sites are required to wear face coverings unless they meet any of the criteria for an exception.

There is increased cleaning across the public transport network to slow the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19), including rail replacement buses.

This includes cleaning high-touch surfaces like next-stop buttons, door handles, myki touch points, handrails and grab straps regularly and deep cleaning trains, trams and buses, stations and stops every night.

# Maintenance and renewal works

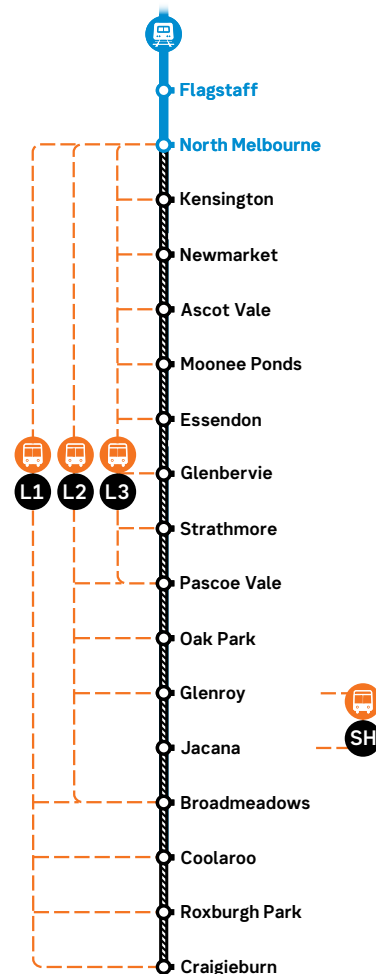

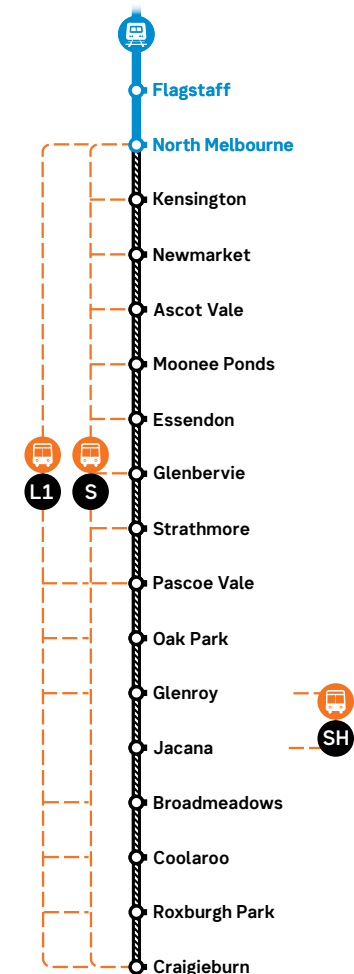
