



Construction Induction (White Card)

Version: 1.0

This course specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work, meeting the general construction induction training requirements of:

- Part 1.1 Definitions and Part 6.5 of the Model Work Health and Safety Regulations;
- Division 11 of Part 3 of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 for Western Australia; and
- Division 3 of Part 5.1 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007 for Victoria.

This training does not displace site-specific induction training that will be conducted prior to conducting construction work.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Identify health and safety legislative requirements of construction work
- Identify construction hazards and risk control measures
- Identify health and safety communication and reporting processes
- Identify incident and emergency response procedures

AUDIENCE

There are no specific requirements for entry into this course

- New and existing workers to the building and construction industry
- Other personnel wishing to attain a White card
