



Dear Colleagues,

Premier Daniel Andrews has confirmed a significant easing of pandemic restrictions across Victoria.

As of 11:59pm yesterday, there are now no restrictions on reasons to leave home – or on the distance that can be travelled by people within Victoria. This means the ‘ring of steel’ around Metropolitan Melbourne is no longer in place. In addition, there has been further easing of restrictions around exercise and recreation, use of community facilities and religious and other ceremonies.

The changes come as Victoria has recorded zero new COVID-19 cases over the past ten days.

Importantly, despite the easing of some restrictions, people who are able to work from home must continue to do so.

We are now working towards what a COVID-Safe return to corporate offices might look like for the New Year and I will have more to say about that soon.

We must all continue to practise the COVID-Safe behaviours that have helped Victoria stop the spread.
