Subject: Message from Raymond: COVID-19 restrictions to be introduced from 6pm in Greater Melbourne



Dear Colleagues,

The Acting Premier James Merlino has just announced changes to Victoria's COVID-19 restrictions, to help stop the spread of the virus. This follows cases of community transmission in Melbourne's north.

This means, from 6pm today in Greater Melbourne:

- Facemasks will be required indoors, for all people aged 12 and over; this includes in all offices and indoor workspaces.
- Private gatherings limited to 5 people per day.
- Public gatherings to 30 people.
- If people from Melbourne visit regional Victoria, they will need to wear a mask even if out of the Greater Melbourne area.

Metro continues to follow the latest public health advice and I'm encouraging you to do the same. The latest information, including a list of exposure sites, will be regularly updated at <u>coronavirus.vic.gov.au</u>

"We're asking anyone who has been to any of the listed exposure sites, to please get tested and isolate as required – and that all Victorians stick to these additional measures so we can continue to stay safe and stay open."
