Dear Colleagues Returning to Offices,

Following the introduction of new restrictions across Greater Melbourne and Raymond's latest message, Metro is extending our workforce bubble model for corporate offices.

This means that:

- **Our current team bubble model will continue for now**, pending further public health updates. Please see below for an updated roster.
- If you feel unwell, including with any COVID-19 symptoms, <u>do not attend the office</u>. Please follow all public health advice, advise your one-up manager and get tested immediately.
- The wearing of face masks is mandatory in all indoor settings, unless an exemption applies.
- Good hand and respiratory hygiene must continue to be practised at all times.
- Visitors continue to require written approval from an Executive Director, prior to attending a corporate office.
- Strong COVIDSafe measures remain in place at all Metro work locations.
