Subject: Message from Rob: COVIDSafe settings to be eased further in Melbourne



Dear Colleagues,

Health Minister Martin Foley has just announced a further easing of restrictions for Metropolitan Melbourne, bringing them into line with Regional Victoria.

This means **from 11:59pm Thursday** (tomorrow):

All of Victoria

- You will need to carry a mask at all times.
- Masks will no longer be required in workplaces where staff do not interact with the public, including in offices.
- Masks are still required while travelling on public transport. Metro employees will also need to wear a mask when their roles require them to interact with passengers and members of the public.
- The limits to private gatherings, of 15 people per day, will remain.

A full list of restrictions and the latest media statement are attached.

Please remember:

- **Strong COVIDSafe measures remain in place at all Metro offices and work locations, including Projects Alliance offices and frontline worksites.** This includes the recent roll-out of the Service Victoria QR Code system, in addition to existing internal check-in requirements.
- **These measures will be unique to each workplace**, so it's important to follow all instructions, relevant to your location. Speak to your manager if you need further information.
- **Vaccines now available to eligible Victorians.** The Department of Health has advised available COVID-19 vaccines are safe. We urge all eligible colleagues to consider the opportunity to get vaccinated.
