Your new Chelsea Station will open and trains will recommence on the Frankston Line on Monday 22 November

Brand new station facilities include:


- Stairs and lifts providing improved accessibility access
- A protective Services Officers (PSO) pod
- CCTV and improved lighting
- Sheltered seating on the platforms

Over the coming months more access points will open, with ramp access available from Nepean Highway and Station Street to get you from street level to the platforms.

Works will continue around the station precinct, including opening the parkiteer cage, bike hoops, car parking, bus interchange and shared use path by early 2022.

The new Edithvale and Bonbeach stations will also open on Monday 22 November.
