



Track Vehicle Operator - 1

DESCRIPTION

This course involves the knowledge and skills required by Rail Safety Workers (RSWs) to operate road/rail vehicles on track within a defined worksite in accordance with safe working regulatory requirements, workplace procedures in the MTM network.

The course will teach the skills and knowledge for RSWs to be able to perform pre-operational and post-operational checks, on tracking and off tracking vehicles, operating equipment, and completing required documentation. It encompasses the operation of all road/rail on-track vehicles.

AUDIENCE

This course MUST be undertaken by any individual required to operate a road/rail vehicle within a "restricted" environment, i.e., within a worksite protected by a method of safe working on the MTM network.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This course will give participants the knowledge and skills to:

- Perform pre-operational equipment checks
- On track and operate road/rail vehicle
- Off track road/rail vehicle
- Perform post-operational equipment procedures
- · Access defined worksite
- Run track vehicle within defined worksite
- Exit defined worksite.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) REQUIREMENTS

Participants MUST bring the following items on the day of training:



Steel capped, lace up boots with ankle support



Full length trousers



Long sleeve



Rail Approved Orange Hi-Vis vest



Eye protection



Hard hat

Participants cannot commence training without PPE

PROOF OF IDENTITY REQUIREMENTS

Participants are required to produce a valid Identification document (ID) on the day of training.

One of the following is considered a valid ID document, the document must contain a photo of the participant and be current.

- Australian or International Passport
- Driver's Licence
- Driver's Learners Permit
- Boat Operator's Licence
- Victorian Firearm Licence
- Licence to Perform High Risk Work
- Consumer Affairs Victoria Proof of Age card
- Other Australian Government issued ID card
- Keypass ID card or Tertiary Education Photo ID card

METRO ACADEMY PREREQUISITES

Participant MUST be 18+ years of age

Participant MUST hold a current driver licence, have completed the approved MTM **Train Track Safety Awareness** course and have been issued the following unit/s of competency:

TLIF0020 Safely access the rail corridor*

Participant MUST have a current Rail Industry Worker (RIW) card / MTM Track Protection card.

* (Units of competency considered equivalent on www.training.gov.au are also accepted)

METRO ACADEMY PREREQUISITE VERIFICATION

Approved photo ID MUST be sighted on day of attendance.

Metro Academy will verify prerequisites against Rail Industry Worker (RIW) database prior to attending the training.

To prevent delay, participant's 'The Platform' profile MUST contain current email address, contact number, RIW number and date of birth.

Verifications will be completed by Metro Academy normally within two (2) business days of receipt of information.

* Participant is unable to commence training until verifications have been completed

COURSE COMPLETION

Participants who successfully complete all requirements of this course will be awarded a Statement of Attainment (SoA) for the following nationally recognised unit/s of competency:

TLIC2054 Access rail track to run track vehicle within

defined worksite

TLIC3045 Operate road/rail vehicle

SoA and CoC will be issued by Metro Academy via email, normally within ten (10) business days.

The CoC competency is accepted on the MTM Metropolitan Rail Network and is valid for 24 months. This competency MUST be renewed before expiration.

RIW CERTIFICATE UPLOADS

Metro Academy will upload the participant's certificate to the RIW database.

To prevent delay, the participants 'The Platform' profile MUST contain current email address, contact number, RIW number, date of birth and the RIW card must also be valid.

Uploads will normally be completed within two (2) business days of SoA and CoC being issued.

INFORMATION/BOOKINGS

This course closes two (2) business days prior to scheduled class attendance to allow for the pre-requisite checks to be completed.
