

Substation Familiarisation

DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to provide the necessary knowledge and skills to become an Instructed Person for substation entry on the Metro Trains Melbourne (MTM) Metropolitan Rail Network.

MANDATORY COMPLIANCE

Completion of this course and upload of Certificate of Completion (CoC) on RIW allows participants to enter a substation on the MTM Network under the supervision of an MTM Substation Authorised Person.

AUDIENCE

This course is for new entrants and other workers required to enter a substation on the MTM Network.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This course will give participants the knowledge and skills to:

- Identify hazards associated with entering a High Voltage location.
- Identify the role and responsibilities of an Instructed and Authorised Person.
- Respond appropriately to an emergency in a substation environment.
